



Book Thong

“Fits perfectly in the crack”

Materials:

Beads and Charms of your choice
2 feet Mastex cord
(heavy Nylon Thread)

Tools:

Awl
Scissors

Directions

Step One: Tie an Overhand Knot at one end of the thread.

Step Two: String your beads as desired.

Step Three: Tie another overhand knot at the other end of the beads. Use an awl inside the loop of the knot as you pull it close to the beads, this will bring the knot nice and tight without slack.

Step Four: Measure about 10" and tie another knot. Use an awl to get it in the right place.

Step Five: String Beads on this end as desired.

Step Six: Tie a final overhand knot at the end of the beads to complete your thong.

Step Seven: Trim excess thread from each end.

Tips:

1. You can apply a little dab of clear nail polish to the end knots to keep them from coming undone, but it is not mandatory.
2. Attach Charms at one or both ends by stringing the charm, then bring the threads together and tie like you would a balloon. (Around your fingers and the end through the loop.)
3. Make it as long or short as you would like. This example works good in medium to large sized books.
